***2. The presence of sensitive receptors.***

**3. Significant impacts due to the project or activity identified.** *List environmental impacts which are likely to be significant (not taking into account control or mitigation measures).*

**4. Impacts which are unknown or uncertain as to the impacts but may occur:**

*List environmental impacts which are uncertain or could arise and require further investigation.*

**5. Social issues**
